








Installing Adobe Creative Cloud (CC) -Apple computers


Step	Action
1.	<p>You need to uninstall any of the Adobe Suite products that are installed on your computer which is any app that says Adobe EXCEPT Adobe Air, Adobe Flash Player, and Adobe Shockwave. Begin by removing any local Adobe Suite Software by opening Finder, selecting the Adobe products and dragging them to the trash can. If you don't have any Adobe products, skip to step 5.</p> 
2.	<p>Open the Trash Can, select those files > Right click > Delete Immediately</p> 
3.	<p>When prompted "Are you sure?" choose Delete</p> 

4.	<p>Finder will prompt you for your credentials to delete those programs. 
8. If it takes you a second Sign in screen, type in your email address: **Username@ut.edu** and click **Sign in with an Enterprise ID**.




9. If the **Choose an account for** screen displays. Select **Enterprise ID**.




10. The **MyUTampa Sign In** screen displays. Type your UT login (**Username**) and password. Click the **Sign In** button.









11. The **Adobe CC Welcome** page displays. Click the **Download Apps** link.




12. Select the Desktop app(s) that you would like to install and click the **Install** button(s). For this example choose **Acrobat DC**.




13.	<p>If you receive this message, click OK</p>

16.	<p>Double Click on the Acrobat DC installer</p> 
17.	<p>Click Open to run the installer</p> 
18.	<p>The Sign in screen displays. Type your UT email address (Username@ut.edu) in the Email address field. Click Sign in with an Enterprise ID</p> 



19. If the **Choose an account for** screen displays. Select **Enterprise ID**.



20. The **MyUTampa Sign In** screen displays. Type your UT logon (**Username**) and password. Click the **Sign In** button.




21. If you get this message, click **Start Installing** and wait for it to install.




The Adobe Creative Cloud application will be installed with your selections.


Note 1
