


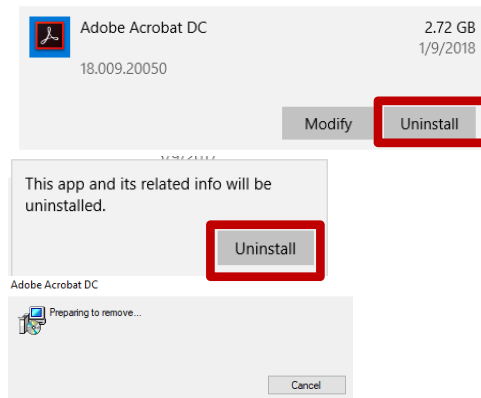


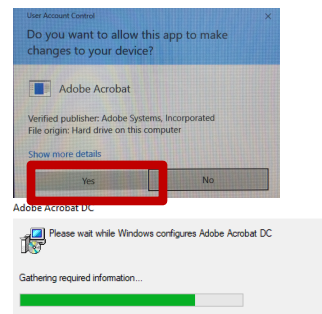
Installing Adobe Creative Cloud (CC) Windows computers

Step	Action
1.	<p>Begin by removing any local Adobe Suite Software (if there are none, skip to step 7) Click on the Windows icon and the settings wheel</p> 
2.	<p>Choose Apps</p> 
3.	<p>You need to uninstall any of the Adobe Suite products that are installed on your computer which is any app that says Adobe EXCEPT Adobe Air, Adobe Flash Player, and Adobe Shockwave.</p> 

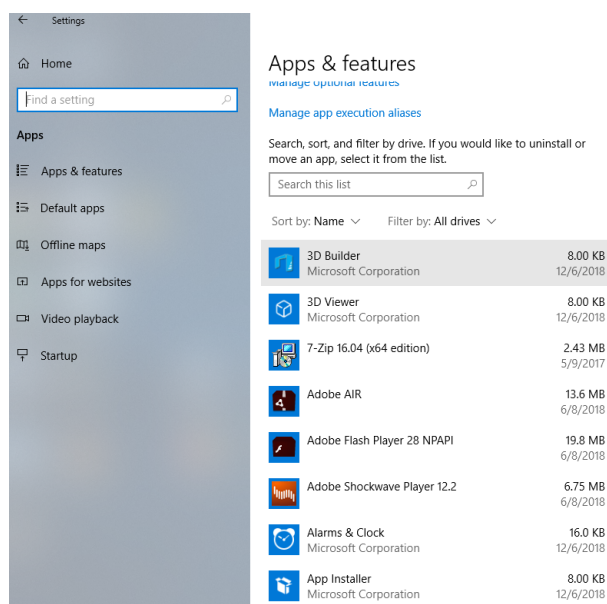
4. Click on the Adobe and choose Uninstall






5. Click yes when prompted to remove the adobe product

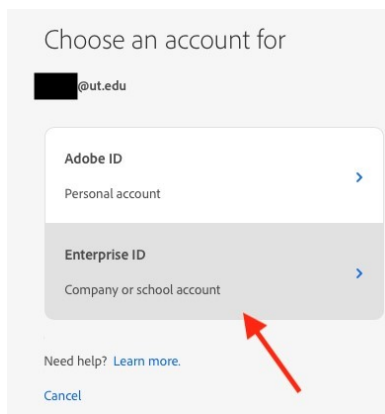


6. Repeat these steps 3 - 5 until the entire Adobe Suite has been removed EXCEPT for the apps Adobe Air, Adobe Flash and Adobe Shockwave. Close the window when done.

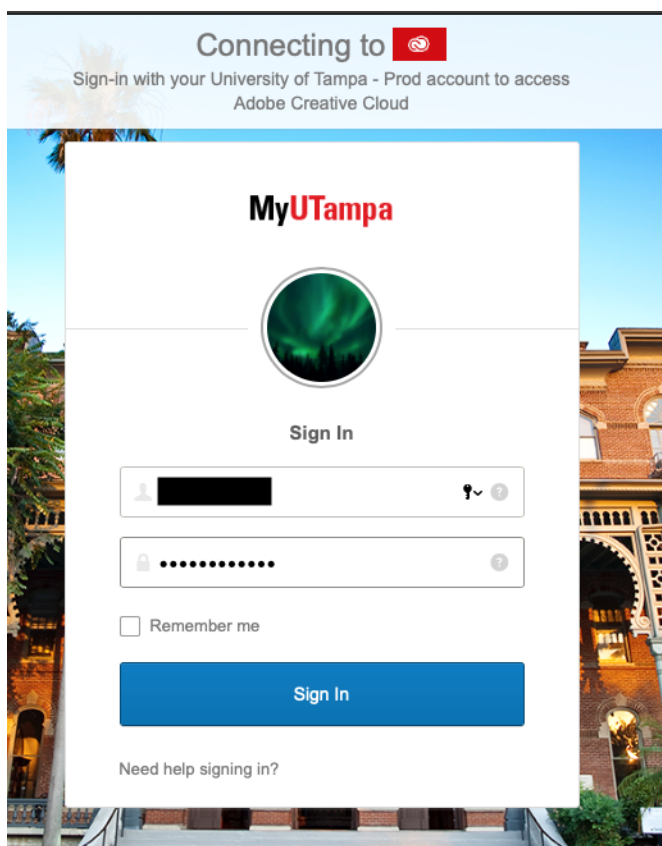

10.	<p>If it takes you a second Sign in screen, type in your email address: Username@ut.edu and click Sign in with an Enterprise ID.</p> 

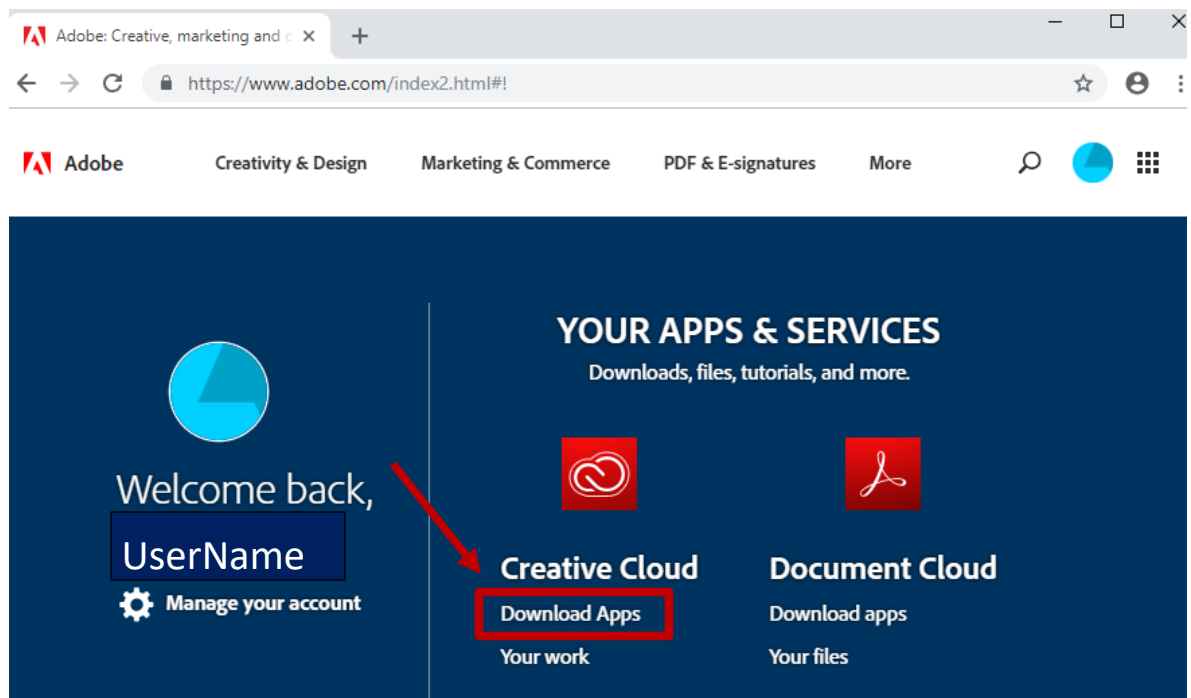
11. If the **Choose an account for** screen displays. Select **Enterprise ID**.



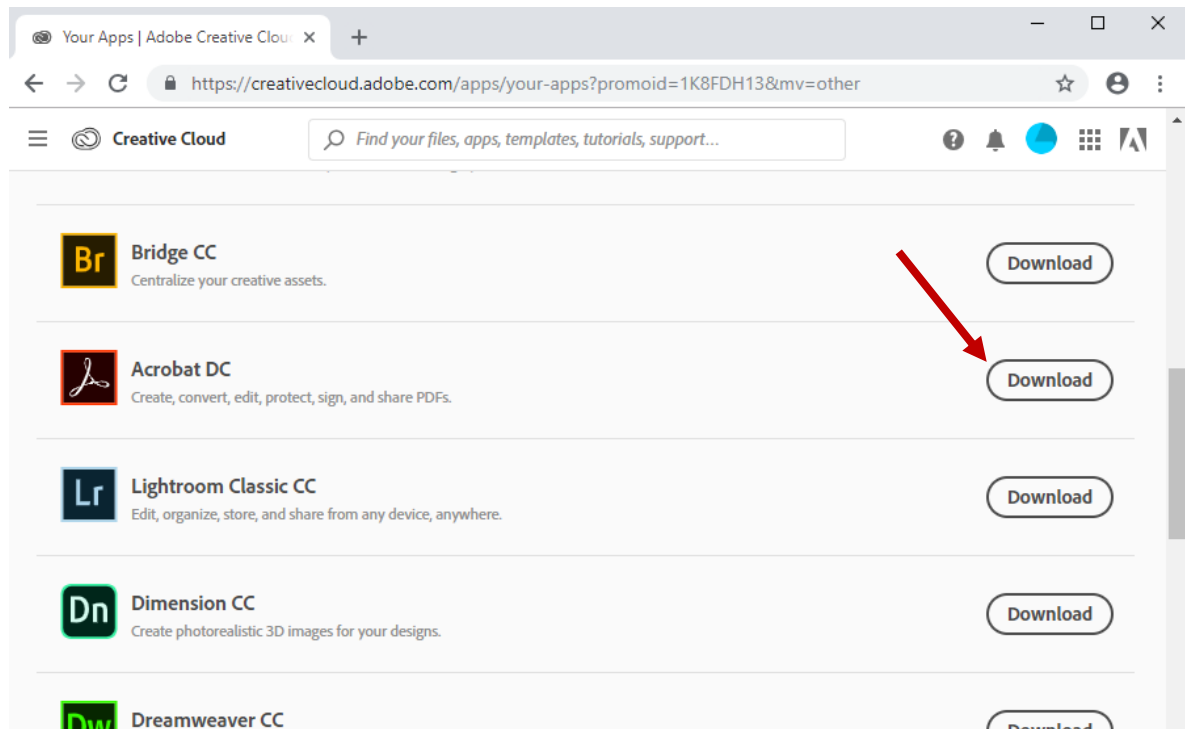
12. The **MyUTampa Sign In** screen displays. Type your UT logon (**Username**) and password. Click the **Sign In** button.






13. The **Adobe CC Welcome** page displays. Click the **Download Apps** link.



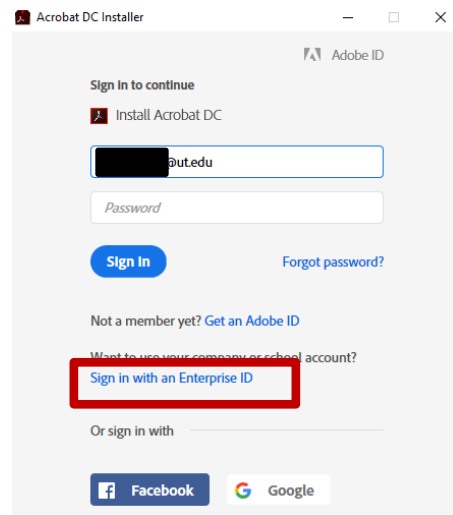
14. Select the Desktop app(s) that you would like to install and click the **Install** button(s). For this example choose **Acrobat DC**.

17.	<p>Select Yes to authorize the installation</p> 

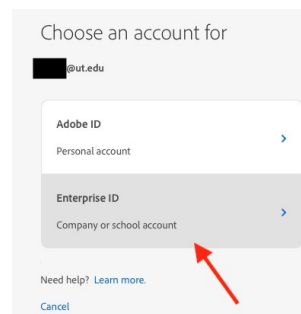

The **Sign in** screen displays. Type your UT email address (**Username@ut.edu**) in the **Email address** field. Click **Sign in with an Enterprise ID**



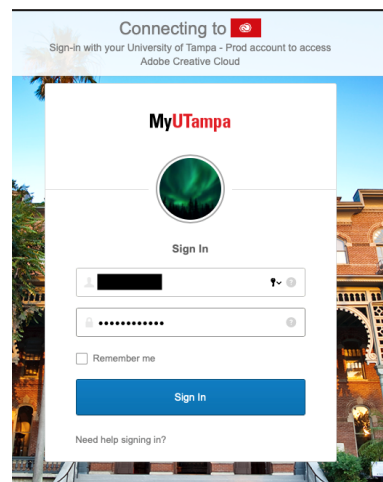

If the **Choose an account for** screen displays. Select **Enterprise ID**.



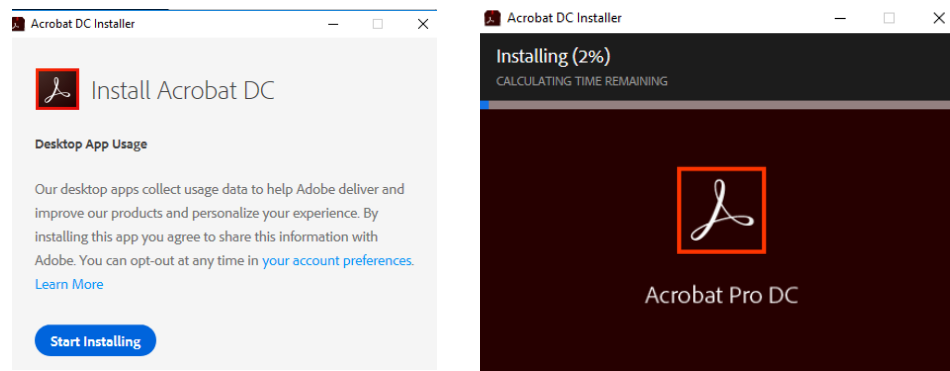

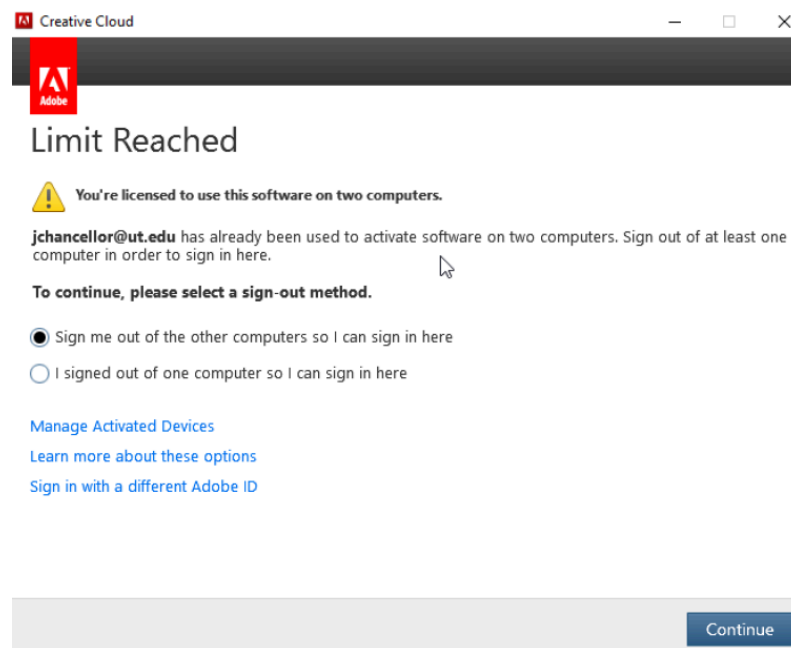
If you get this message, click **Start Installing** and wait for it to install.




The Adobe Creative Cloud application will be installed with your selections.

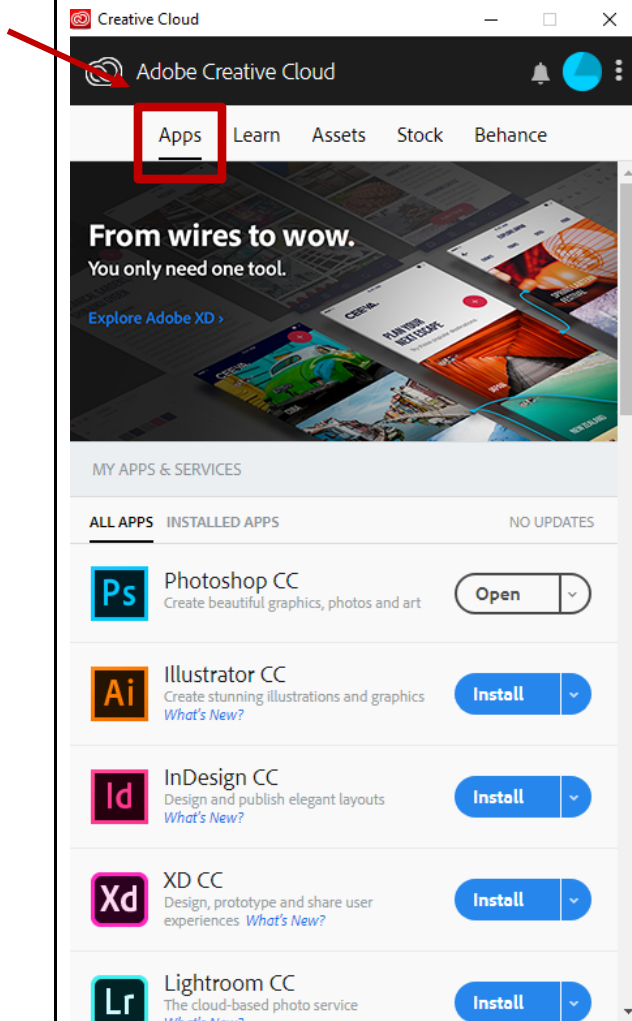
Note 1
